Paddy Outlook - December 2019

Paddy is cultivated globally being one of the most important cereal crops worldwide. As per USDA report the global production of rice may fall to 49.84 million tonnes in 2019-20 season. According to USDA, production in China and India is estimated to decline. Rice production is likely to be reduced by 2.5 million tonnes in China and 4.42 million tonnes in India.

As per the ministry of Agriculture, rabi rice acreage as on 28nd November 2019 has increased by 10.85% to 8.17 lakh hectares as compared to 7.37 lakh hectares during the same period of last year. Higher acreage was covered in Tamil Nadu (7.66 lakh ha) and Andhra Pradesh (0.30 lakh ha). Whereas, lower acreage was reported from major states such as Karnataka (0.02 lakh ha) and Telangana (0.12 lakh ha).

In Telangana, it has been sown in 6883 hectares as on 04th December 2019 which is lower than 9044 hectares covered during corresponding period of last year. Major paddy growing districts in Telangana are Nalgonda (2000 ha), Medak (1250 ha), Jagtiyal (690 ha), Kamareddy (675 ha), Yadadri (329 ha) and Sangareddy (124 ha).

Modal prices of Paddy-Grade-A (RNR) at Kesamudram market and Paddy-Common at Suryapet market ranged between Rs. 1789-2453 and Rs. 1359-1589 per quintal during November 2019 respectively. The Government has increased MSP of normal grade paddy by 65 rupees to Rs. 1815 and 'A' grade Paddy to Rs. 1835 per quintal.

Paddy Price Outlook

Vietnam rice export prices rose to a four-and-a-half-month high this week on healthy demand from Africa and Cuba as a supply.

Many rice-growing states received rainfall earlier this month, which delayed harvesting and damaged paddy crops ready for harvesting. In the current kharif marketing season, a total of 230.27 lakh tonnes of paddy has been purchased from farmers in various states of the country by the Food Corporation of India (FCI) and its associated provincial agencies. Bulbul storms (cyclone) has damaged paddy crop in West Bengal (0.9 m ha) and Odisha (0.07 m ha).

Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTSAU expects that Paddy-Grade-A (RNR) could trade in a range of Rs. 1900-2100 per quintal and Paddy-Common could trade in a range of Rs. 1400-1550 per quintal during the month of December, 2019.
