Groundnut Outlook – December 2020

Groundnut (*Arachishypogaea L.*) is an important oilseed crop in India which occupies first position in terms of area and second position in terms of production. China ranks first in groundnut production with 17.39 million tonnes followed by India 6.70 million tonnes, Nigeria 2.89 lakh tonnes, Sudan 2.88 million tonnes and Myanmar 1.60 million tonnes accounting for 37, 14, 6, 2 and 1 percent of total world production of 46.01 million tonnes during 2018-19.

According to the all India kharif crop coverage report, Government of India, as on 18th September 2020, groundnut was sown in around 50.95 lakh hectares as compared to last year (39.12 lakh ha). Among the states, Gujarat stood first in area coverage with 20.65 lakh ha followed by Andhra Pradesh (7.50 lakh ha), Rajasthan (7.28 lakh ha), Karnataka (5.37 lakh ha), and Madhya Pradesh (2.80 lakh ha).

Groundnut Price Outlook

There has been a high demand for peanuts from exporters particularly oil mills and as a result of it, prices of good quality peanuts in the open markets hovered around Rs. 6000 per quintal, which is much higher than Minimum Support Price (MSP) of Rs. 5275 per quintal. Peanuts with high moisture content fetched price of Rs 5000-5200 per quintal.

Peanut demand has risen and exports are expected to rise by 10% in 2020-21, as exporters are getting good orders from China, Southeast Asia and Europe.

India exported 34,535 tons of peanut in August 2020, as against 19,225 tons same period last year. During April to August 2020, peanut exports were 13% higher year-on-year to 174,610 tons, valued at Rs 1,570 crore.

As per Indian Oilseed and Produce Export Promotion Council (IOPEPC) estimate, India's new crop peanut output is expected to reach 7.70 million tonnes.

Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTSAU expects that groundnut may trade in a range of **Rs. 3900** – **4250** per quintal during the month of December 2020.
