Groundnut Outlook – September 2020

Groundnut (*Arachis hypogaea L.*) is an important oilseed crop in India which occupies first position in terms of area and second position in terms of production. China ranks first in groundnut production with 17.39 million tonnes followed by India 6.70 million tonnes, Nigeria 2.89 lakh tonnes, Sudan 2.88 million tonnes and Myanmar 1.60 million tonnes accounting for 37, 14, 6, 2 and 1 percent of total world production of 46.01 million tonnes during 2018-19.

According to the all India kharif crop coverage report, Government of India, as on 3rd September 2020, groundnut was sown in around 50.72 lakh hectares as compared to last year (38.13 lakh ha). Among the states, Gujarat stood first in area coverage with 20.65 lakh ha followed by Andhra Pradesh (7.49 lakh ha), Rajasthan (7.28 lakh ha), Karnataka (5.25 lakh ha), and Madhya Pradesh (2.80 lakh ha).

In Telangana, groundnut has been sown in around 34,133 acres as on 2nd September 2020. Among the districts, Gadwal stood first in groundnut sown area with 13,797 acres followed by Warangal (Rural) (7261 acres), Nagarkurnool (3564 acres), Wanaparthy (2557 acres) and Suryapet (1756 acres).

In Suryapet market about 28 quintals of groundnut was traded in price range of Rs. 3,659 - 4,579 per quintal during August 2020.

Groundnut Price Outlook

The government aims to produce 7.81 million tonnes groundnut in 2020-21 kharif season, up sharply from last year's 5.31 million tonnes.

The groundnut seeds continued downtrend, on bearish supply outlook for the new kharif season given the surge in sown area and the expectation of a bigger harvest. Higher imports from less developed countries in Africa may further dampen sentiment for the groundnut and fading export demand and shrinking demand from oil millers may depress the groundnut prices further.

NAFED has disposed 3.88 lakh tonnes of groundnut in the states of Gujarat and Rajasthan, including stocks from Kharif'18 and Kharif'19.

India's groundnut oil exports are seen rising to around 50,000 tonnes in 2020-21 (Apr-Mar) from 40,000 tonnes last year.

According to the Solvent Extractors' Association of India, India's groundnut imports were nearly doubled to 520,871 tonnes in 2019-20 (Apr-Mar).

According to Saurashtra Oil Mills Association, the country's groundnut stock is seen steady at 2.8-3 lakh tonnes as of now.

Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTSAU expects that groundnut may trade in a range of $\mathbf{Rs.}\ 4200-4500$ per quintal during the month of September 2020.
